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2017 RULES AND REGULATIONS (updated 5/9/2017)

Please read the following; signing the application page acknowledges your agreement to these rules. The 2017 fair queens are also required to abide by these rules after receiving their title.

1. ALL contestants must physically reside in Shenandoah County; the use of family addresses for eligibility purposes when living outside the county will result in immediate disqualification or loss of title.
2. Contestants must be female who has always been female, single, never married, without children, and never having been pregnant.
3. Contestant must possess strong moral character. Individuals are not allowed to compete if they have ever been convicted of a crime, have any pending criminal charges, or have committed an act or engaged in an activity which is or could be characterized as dishonest, immoral, indecent, or in bad taste. These regulations also apply to improper images/actions on all social media outlets. Any images/videos/messages submitted to the Directors will be taken to the Pageant Committee for immediate review, which may result in disqualification.
4. All contestants must enter the division corresponding with their age as of pageant day, no exceptions. All winners are required to sit out one (1) year; they will be eligible to compete again in the 2018 pageant, if they have reached the minimum age for the next age division (may not win the same title/age division twice).
5. Contestant line-up will be determined by the order applications are received, not postmarked (first in, last out).
6. All Miss Division contestants are required to attend a mandatory orientation session on Sunday, July 23rd at 3PM in the Shenandoah County Fair Office.
7. Evening pageant contestants are required to attend the mandatory rehearsal on Friday, August 18th.
8. The First Runner-Up in each age division must be willing to assume all duties in the event that the winner is unable or unwilling to fulfill her duties.
9. The 2017 titleholders are required to attend/participate/abide in/by the following:
 - The 2017 SCFSP Titleholder Meeting on Sunday, August 20th (time is TBD, will be in afternoon hours). The 2017 titleholder agreement will be signed, fair week activities will be discussed, and general information about the year will be provided.)
 - The 100th Shenandoah County Fair Anniversary Parade, to be held on Thursday, August 24th (line-up is at 5:45PM/parade starts at 6:30PM).
 - The 100th Anniversary Ribbon Cutting Ceremony, to be held on Saturday, August 26th (approx. 11AM)
 - Other events as requested by the Board of Directors, Pageant Committee, and Pageant Directors.
 - All appearances in Shenandoah County must be made with the fair crown/sash, yet signs for other titles may be used in parades. All appearances outside of county *should* be made with the fair title. All exceptions *must* be presented to directors in advance for approval.
 - The new Miss Shenandoah County Fair *must* make all appearances with her fair title *only*, per the committee and board; in addition, she may not compete for another title while holding this title (August 2017 – August 2018).
10. The 2017 Miss Shenandoah County Fair will compete in the 2018 Miss Virginia Association of Fairs Scholarship Pageant, to be held the weekend of January 4th – 7th at The Omni Homestead Resort in Hot Springs, VA. The queen will work *strictly* with the Pageant Directors and assigned resources. Additional information about the Miss title will be discussed at the titleholder meeting.
11. All contestants and family/guests must conduct themselves in a proper manner at all times throughout pageant weekend. Any display of uncooperative or unsportsmanlike conduct will result in immediate disqualification of the contestant and removal of the individuals from the property. Incidents will also be directed to the fair pageant committee/fair board with the potential of the individual(s) being banned from the scholarship pageant program as a contestant; this applies to incidents before/during/after the pageant, if related to the pageant.

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2017 AREAS OF COMPETITION

The following are the areas of competition for the 2017 SCFSP, broken down for each age group, including the wardrobe requirements and judging criteria. Please note that ALL age divisions will be participating in the photogenic competition.

PHOTOGENIC

All contestants will participate in our photogenic competition; this will require each person to have a headshot picture done by our official pageant photographer. These pictures will be judged by our qualified panel of judges on pageant day and will also be printed in our award-winning full-color program book. Our 2017 fair pageant photographer is Kimberly Needles with Kimberly Needles Photography. All contestants are *required* to schedule their headshot with Kimberly in advance. Please see page 4 for more information.

PRIVATE PANEL INTERVIEW (Miss contestants only)

- **Miss.** A five-minute panel-style interview with judges. Judging will focus on personality, poise, speaking/conversational ability, and overall impression. At the 4:30 mark of the interview, the contestant will be stopped and given 30 seconds to finish answering the current question OR make a final statement OR conclude the interview. Information on the interview fact sheet will be provided at the July 23rd Miss Contestant meeting.

OPENING NUMBER (evening contestants only)

- **Pre-Teen Miss/Jr Teen Miss/Teen Miss/Miss.** The opening event of the evening pageant, contestants will perform a simple dance routine and introduce themselves (name, age, town). Attire will be the official 2017 SCFSP t-shirt (provided at rehearsals), black bottoms (shorts or pants, no skirts), and shoes/jewelry of choice.

GOWN

- **Tiny Miss/Little Miss.** Gown/dress of choice. Tiny Miss and Little Miss may wear “Sunday Best/Flower Girl” or pageant attire (no “heavy glitz”); dress may be short or long and have rhinestones/ruffles. Judging will focus on personality and overall impression.
- **Young Miss/Pre-Teen Miss.** Gown/dress of choice. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression. No strapless gowns.
- **Jr Teen Miss.** Gown/dress of choice. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression. Gown may be strapless but should not have a slit.
- **Teen Miss.** Gown/dress of choice. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression. Gown may be strapless and have a slit (should not come above knee).
- **Miss.** Gown/dress of choice. Judging will focus on appearance, gown, personality, overall impression.

PERSONALITY WEAR (evening contestants only)

- **Pre-Teen Miss/Jr Teen Miss/Teen Miss/Miss.** Outfit of choice that best suits your personality. Fast-paced modeling with music.

ON-STAGE QUESTION (evening contestants only)

- **Pre-Teen Miss/Jr Teen Miss/Teen Miss/Miss.** An on-stage, unrehearsed question to identify the impromptu public speaking ability of each contestant.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

- In the event of a tie during the tabulation of scores, all divisions will be broken using the highest overall impression score. For the Miss division, the judges without interaction from pageant staff will break the tie; all categories for the Miss division will be evaluated in breaking the tie.
- Scoresheets will be available in the fair office starting Friday, September 1st.



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2017 PHOTOGENIC/PROGRAM BOOK PICTURE INFORMATION

As in the past, each contestant is expected to have a headshot picture taken by the official fair pageant photographer; this image will be used in the photogenic competition, as well as be printed in our program book. As in the past, this is FREE to our contestants!

NEW THIS YEAR: For our 2017 pageant, we are beyond excited to announce that Kimberly Needles Photography is our new official pageant photographer. Kimberly has a phenomenal reputation as a pageant photographer, specializing in both portraits and action photography. Prints of the photogenic headshots are available for purchase and Kimberly will also be offering a setting for gown portraits on pageant day.

PORTRAIT SESSIONS

Kimberly will be at the fair office to take headshot pictures as follows:

- Monday, July 24th (3PM – 8PM)

All sessions will be held on the second floor of the fair office (300 Fairground Rd – Woodstock)

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

This will be a headshot (from the chest up); please wear a **BLACK** top with sleeves (short or long, no sleeveless), no prints or patterns. If you cannot find black, please wear something dark (i.e. navy blue). Kimberly will be using a dark grey background.

When selecting a top and accessories, please keep them age-appropriate and remember: do not let large jewelry and hair accessories overshadow the face.
